What is GS?

The Genuine Student (GS) form is the new requirement that replaces the previous Genuine Temporary Entrant (GTE) form. All international student visa applicants must demonstrate that they are genuine candidates for entry.

All applicants for a student visa must be a genuine applicant for entry. They must stay as a student and be able to show an understanding that studying in Australia is the primary reason of their student visa. The GS requirement is intended to include students who, after studying in Australia, develop skills Australia needs and who then go on to apply for permanent residence.

Please use the guidelines below for your GS criterion and ensure that your GS criterion is completed by yourself. You must limit the response to each question below to a maximum of 150 words only and provide evidence of any claims made in the statements below.
